



MOSAIC > SECONDARY SCHOOL MENTORING PROGRAMME

This fully-funded programme runs over eight sessions that map in to your school's curriculum map. It connects dedicated volunteer mentors from a variety of backgrounds and professions to schools across the UK. It is usually delivered face-to-face but can be delivered online to accommodate government Covid-19 restrictions if required.

How does Mosaic Mentoring benefit young people?

- Closes the gap between aspirations and attainment by connecting young people with positive relatable role models
- Supports young people to build their confidence
Develops employability skills such as communication, teamwork and career planning

What's involved?

Groups of up to 30 students work with mentors who deliver activities tailored to students' needs. If online delivery is required, numbers will depend on the desired set up as young people will need access to a laptop and headphones.

The programme includes:

- One rapport-building introductory session
- Six sessions planned by the mentors according to the students' needs
- World of work visit and inspirational speaker

Trained mentors to inspire your students

Our trained volunteers will be relatable role models for students. Our mentors come from a range of diverse backgrounds and professions so students can aspire to careers in a variety of different sectors. All mentors undergo DBS checks.

- Eight weeks of sessions, starting with a 30 minute introduction, followed by seven 90 minute sessions
- Delivered face-to-face or online, flexible around your school timetable
- Trained mentors will help students build confidence
- Students will gain an insight into careers in a variety of sectors
