What Is The Qualification?

- Land-based Service Engineering Technician, level 3 – the course duration is three years
- As a Engineer/Fitter you will be trained in all aspects of repair and maintenance of equipment, learning about; diagnostics, complex parts, write-offs and mechanical/hydraulic repairs
- This qualification is recognised across the Hire Industry and will help you to secure employment as a Fitter or Engineer.

The Course

- This is a workplace qualification where you work alongside a mentor (Monday to Friday, 8am-5pm) in a branch/depot for 40 hours per week
- You will also attend a college. This involves two week blocks where you live on the campus away from home (expenses are covered when at college)
- At college you attend workshop training sessions, class room theory and complete exams
- The course work is broken into three years and deadlines/timescales must be adhered to throughout.
- **After successful completion and qualification attained we guarantee a job at the end of this scheme.**

Qualifications Required

- The minimum criteria required to join this course is:
 - **GCSE grade 4 - 9 or A – C in Maths and English**
 - **Scottish National 5 in Maths and English**
- As the qualification requires theory and coursework to be completed to minimum “pass” levels, the above grades are essential.
